2 Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

#### James 5:16b-18

16b The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

**17 Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are**, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.

18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.

#### James 4:3

When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with **wrong motives**, **that you may spend what you get on your pleasures**.

# Jesus assures us in Mark 11:23-24 that if we pray with belief and trust that our desires will be granted, we WILL receive them.

In 1 John 5:14-15, we are reminded of the confidence we have before God when we pray according to His will.

The passage tells us that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

This assurance should ignite a fire within us to seek His will in our prayers and align our desires with His.

To pray according to God's will, we must first set our hearts and minds on things above, as mentioned in **Colossians 3:1-2**.

As believers, we have been raised with Christ, and our focus should be on heavenly things, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.

By shifting our attention away from earthly matters and fixing our gaze on God's kingdom, we position ourselves to understand His will and pray accordingly.

# God's language

Did you know that God has His own language, it is called the love language.

The Bible teaches us to speak with other tongues, as that WILL build your spirit, and make it stronger.

The Apostle Paul extensively discussed the topic of speaking in "other tongues" and demonstrated his own commitment to it.

In fact, he confidently declared, "I thank my God I speak with tongues more than all of you" (1 Corinthians 14:18).

# Praying in other tongues is a 2 way communication.

You pray to God, but God is also speaking to your spirit.

1 Corinthians 14:1-5

1 Follow the way of love and eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy.

2 For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to people but to God.

Indeed, no one understands them; they utter mysteries by the Spirit.

3 But the one who prophesies **speaks to people** for their strengthening, encouragement and comfort.

4 Anyone who speaks in a tongue **edifies themselves**, but the one who prophesies edifies the church.

5 I would like every one of you to speak in tongues, but I would rather have you prophesy.

The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, **so that the church may be edified.** 

You speak mysteries that other people and our enemy the Devil do not understand.

# Interpretation

13 the one who speaks in a tongue should pray that they may interpret what they say.

15 I will pray with my spirit, but I will also pray with my understanding; I will sing with my spirit, but I will also sing with my understanding.

18 I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you.

19 But in the church I would rather speak five intelligible words to instruct others than ten thousand words in a tongue.

Praying in other tongues is very effective, because you are using a place in your brain that is not affected by the language centre.

Speaking in tongues is an **initial evidence**, or **sign**, of the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

### Acts 2:4

"And they were filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance" .

# The background for effective prayer

**1 Corinthians 1:30** reminds us that our righteousness and holiness come from God through Christ.

It is not something we can achieve on our own.

Recognizing this truth humbles us and allows us to approach God with a heart of gratitude, acknowledging His grace and mercy in our lives.

When we pray from a place of gratitude and surrender, we align ourselves with His will.

**James 5:16b-18** further emphasises the power and effectiveness of prayer.
