# You got the weapons to fight this war.

#### 2 Corinthians 10:3-5

3 For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does.

4 The weapons we fight with **are not the weapons of the world.** On the contrary, **they have divine power to demolish strongholds.** 

5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

# It matters how you think.

Your thoughts are a window into your spiritual heart.

The word "heart" is found between 500-800+ times in the Bible, depending on the version of the Bible you are reading.

#### Proverbs 4:23

Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life.

This is a real war happening, and you need to know who is fighting you.

#### Ephesians 6:12

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against **principalities**, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

There is a war, spiritually. And your mind/ heart is at the centre of that war.

In Daniel 10:12-14 we find the story about Daniel's encounter with an angel from the Lord.

12 Then he continued, "Do not be afraid, Daniel.

Since the first day that you set your mind to gain understanding and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard, and I have come in response to them.

13 But the prince of the Persian kingdom resisted me twenty-one days.

Then Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, because I was detained there with the king of Persia.

14 Now I have come to explain to you what will happen to your people in the future, for the vision concerns a time yet to come."

In the realm of spirituality, there exists a constant battle, a war that rages on within our lives.
