There are many stories I could tell you about people that experienced a Purpose Driven Life.

The story about Joseph

Genesis chapter 37-50

Joseph was one of Jacob's 12 sons.

His father loved him more than any of the others and gave him a coloured cloak.

His brothers were jealous of him and sold him into slavery.

He was taken to Egypt and eventually became steward to Potiphar, one of Pharaoh's officials.

Joseph had many ups and downs.

He was arrested, put in prison. He was there for years.

But his belief was unwavering through all his sufferings, and helping the prison guard and other inmates.

After correctly interpreting the dreams of Pharaoh, however, he rises to second-in-command in Egypt and saves Egypt during a famine.

He even saved his own family from dying from famine.

So you understand that this story is not about Joseph' self Centeredness and all his needs.

LISTEN! It's not about you!

Like the story about Joseph, the story of your life is not about you.

Self-centeredness has a severe impact on relationships and personal growth and is devastating.

There are a lot of negative effects of always putting yourself first, such as strained relationships and missed opportunities.

This even affects your family, business opportunities, and the church.

Ephesians 3:19

and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

To live a fulfilling life you need to be filled with the love that God gives you.

It is the Agape love of God IN you that makes life worth living.

What does the Agape Love (God's kind of Love) do in your life?

- It makes you sure that God loves you.
- It makes you focus on Jesus
- It makes you consider others' perspectives

1 Kings 3:5-13

5 At Gibeon the Lord appeared to Solomon in a dream by night, and God said, "**Ask what I shall give you.**"

6 And Solomon said, "You have shown great and steadfast love to your servant David my father, because he walked before you in faithfulness, in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart toward you. **And you have kept for him this great and steadfast love** and have given him a son to sit on his throne this day.

7 And now, O Lord my God, you have made your servant king in place of David, my father, although I am but a little child. I do not know how to go out or come in.

8 And your servant is in the midst of your people whom you have chosen, a great people, too many to be numbered or counted for multitude.

9 Give your servant therefore an understanding mind to govern your people, that I may discern between good and evil, for who is able to govern these great people?"

10 It pleased the Lord that Solomon had asked this.
