

# Fearless Faith: The Secret to Unshakable Belief

**What if your faith could move mountains?**

I think it's human nature to want the easy way out without having to venture into the unknown, but God wants us to trust Him completely, especially when we're afraid of the unknown.

Fearless Faith is when we have an Unshakable belief and trust in God's promises.

## **My testimony**

When I was 14 years old I received Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior.

Since I was born I have had a handicap and I could not walk like other children.

In my left ankle there was a piece of my ankle bone missing.

I started to read the Bible and soon I understood that Jesus could heal me.

I went to church on Sunday, and in the middle of the meeting the pastor asked if anybody had a testimony or a song or a Bible verse.

## **I stood up and read the Bible verse from James 5:14-15**

14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up;

After everybody had gone out from the church, the elders prayed for me and anointed me with oil, but nothing seems to happen.

After prayer, I was able to get out of the church where all the youth were waiting to see what had happened to me.

I stood with my back to the wall, so it should look like I was able to stand normally.

Then my best friend came over to me and asked me: What happened.

I told him what happened.

He asked me, but what happened to me, did I get healed in my leg?

I answered him, that according to the Bible in James:

And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; **the Lord will raise them up.** James 5:15

**I said: The Lord has raised me up now.**

My friend then said: If you are healed, then stamp your leg in the asphalt, then we will see what will happen.

**I knew that I could not do that without falling in pain....**

In my mind there was a great battle between belief and unbelief, but I thought that if the Bible is true, then I can do it.

In a split second I decided I would do it.

When the leg reached the asphalt, there was no pain. I was healed.

From that moment I could walk completely normal.

## **Faith like the mustard seed**

### **Matthew 17:14-20**

14 When they came to the crowd, a man approached Jesus and knelt before him.

15 “Lord, have mercy on my son,” he said. “He has seizures and is suffering greatly. He often falls into the fire or into the water.

16 I brought him to your disciples, but they could not heal him.”

17 “You unbelieving and perverse generation,” Jesus replied, “how long shall I stay with you? How long shall I put up with you? Bring the boy here to me.”

18 Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of the boy, and he was healed at that moment.

19 Then the disciples came to Jesus in private and asked, “Why couldn’t we drive it out?”

20 He replied, “Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you.”

## **With God all things are possible**

### **Matthew 19:25-26**

When his disciples heard it, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, Who then can be saved?

26 But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but **with God all things are possible.**

## **With God all things are possible**

This is a most misunderstood verse in the Bible.

Most christians believe that for God all things are possible.

And they think that because God is God, the creator of everything He can also do anything.

And that is true.

But what does the Bible really say here?

The greek word for “with” here is para.

It can also mean: from beside, by the side of, by, beside

**That means that something needs to be beside God for all things to be possible.**

**And that something or should I say someone that needs to be beside God for the impossible could be possible is YOU.**

**So I could say that: You with God, then anything is possible.**

Jesus said to his disciples: YOU GO and heal the sick.

Faith for healing is not faith that God can heal,

because we know that HE can, but it is a belief that YOU + God the Holy Spirit are able to heal.

It is still Jesus that is the healer, and because Jesus is in you and YOU ARE in HIM, He will use YOU to heal, to channel the power of God thru you to others.

## **Salvation**

The same belief we need to work out your salvation like we read in (Philippians 2:12)

It is always ME + God

Jesus died for me at the cross and took all my sins there.

But I have to seek God, by reading/ studying the Word of God, learn the promises of God, and communicate with Him in prayers.

This is how I work out my salvation.

I am not working out my salvation to be saved, but because I am now saved.

It does not make me more righteous or holy, because I am already righteous and holy.

As a believer, we should be declaring that we are Righteous, Holy, Sanctified and Perfected in Christ. If you have a hard time doing this, **you are looking at yourself and not Jesus.**

The Greek word used in the New Testament for holy is the same word used for sanctified. If it says you're holy, it means you're sanctified and vice versa too.

**Greek: Hagiazó - Short Definition: I make holy, sanctify**

**And by that will, we have been made holy/sanctified through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. Heb 10:10 NIV**

Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified/made holy, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God. 1 Cor 6:11 NASB  
For both He who sanctifies and those who are sanctified/holy are all from one [Father]; for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren Heb 2:11 NASB

## **We have to look to Jesus**

I think you agree with me that the apostle of Peter had Fearless Faith when he asked Jesus to ask him to come to Him on the water in (Matthew 14:22-33)

That fearless Faith stopped working when he started to look around him, and saw the bad weather and the waves..

Fear came into Peter's mind and he asked Jesus to rescue him.

And we know what happened.

Peter started out on his own faith, but started to fear, and had to return to the boat with Jesus faith.

When you get out of your boat, don't go out with your faith, but Jesus faith.

Anything is possible when You believe that you and Jesus in you can do it.

Do not lose sight of Jesus, but focus on Jesus in You all the time.

Jesus is IN YOU, you are IN HIM.

You are one with Jesus and the Father and with the Holy Spirit.

Whatever the Holy Spirit is leading you to do, be bold and fearless.
