# Sermon Title: "Act As If God Is Within You"

Scripture Reference:

"Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?" — 1 Corinthians 3:16 (ESV)

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." — Philippians 4:13 (NKJV)

"Greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world." — 1 John 4:4 (NKJV)

### Introduction:

Today, we are diving into a powerful truth: "Act As If God Is Within You."

This is not just a motivational phrase; it is a divine reality that can change the path of your life.

Many of us live beneath our calling, feeling frustrated, restless, and stuck.

But the truth is, God has already filled you.

The power that raised Christ from the dead lives inside you (Romans 8:11).

The question is, are you living like it?

### Romans 10:6-10 (NIV)

6 But the righteousness that is by faith says: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down)

7 "or 'Who will descend into the deep?'" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).

8 But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the message concerning faith that we proclaim:

9 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

### I. You Are Not Empty—You Are Full of Power

Ephesians 1:19-20)

Too many believers walk through life acting like they're running empty.

- They wake up with no expectation.
- They speak with no conviction.
- They move with no authority.

But if you are a child of God, that mindset has no place in your life.

## Ephesians 1:19–20 (NIV):

"I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him.

This is the mighty power that worked in Christ when God raised him from the dead..."

# Truth:

God did not give you partial power.

He gave you full access to His divine authority.

- When He saved you, He sealed you.
- When He called you, He equipped you.
- When He breathed life into you, He breathed destiny.

You are not waiting on God to pour something new into you.

He already filled you.

# II. Stop Living Like a Victim—Embrace Your Kingdom Identity (Galatians 5:1)

Many people live with a victim mentality —blaming circumstances, past pain, or people's opinions for their current state.

But God never called you to be a victim.

You were designed to dominate, to subdue, to steward, and to influence.

### Galatians 5:1 (NIV):

"It is for freedom that Christ has set us free.

Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery."

### Romans 8:1 (NIV):

"Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."

### Truth:

Your past does not define your future.

You are not what happened to you—you are what God says about you.

Victim mentality says, "Life happens to me."

Kingdom identity says, "God works through me."

### **Action Step:**

Start speaking life over your situation.

Stop saying, "Why did this happen to me?" Start saying, "How is God going to use this for His glory?"

Stop saying, "I'm broken." Start declaring, "I'm being built."

# III. Speak with Authority—Heaven Backs Your Words (Proverbs 18:21)

The world speaks from what they see. But kingdom citizens speak from what God has said. Your words have creative power.

### Proverbs 18:21 (NIV):

"The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit."

### Mark 11:23 (NIV):

"Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them."

## Truth:

When you speak with faith and authority, heaven backs your words.

The world says, "I'm broke."

You declare, "I am blessed and highly favored."

The world says, "There's no way out." You say, "God makes a way where there is no way."

# Action Step:

Start declaring what God has promised.

Declare healing: "By His stripes, I am healed." (Isaiah 53:5)

Declare favor: "I am blessed above and beyond." (Deuteronomy 28:13)

Declare authority: "I have power over the enemy." (Luke 10:19)

# IV. Your Actions Must Reflect God's Presence Within You (James 2:17)

Faith without works is dead.

You may believe God is in you, but your actions must prove it.

Your behavior, discipline, attitude, and habits should reveal that God is with you.

### James 2:17 (NIV):

"In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead."

# Colossians 3:23 (NIV):

"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters..."

# Truth:

You are a walking, talking, breathing ambassador of the kingdom.

Every decision you make, every conversation you have, every environment you step into should reflect that God is in you.

# Action Step:

Live like someone who has been called, chosen, and anointed.

- Show up like heaven sent you.
- Walk like you are already qualified.
- Move like your vision is already funded.

# V. Faith Requires Movement, Not Just Belief (Hebrews 11:6)

- Faith is not passive.
- Faith is aggressive.
- Faith takes territory.
- Faith knocks on doors.
- Faith submits the application.
- Faith launches the business.

# Hebrews 11:6 (NIV):

"And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him."

#### Joshua 6:1–20:

- The walls of Jericho fell when the people marched in faith.
- Peter walked on water when he 9stepped out of the boat.
- The woman with the issue of blood was healed when she pressed through the crowd.

### Truth:

Miracles are connected to movement.

God is waiting on your obedience.

Every promise in the Bible is yours, but you must activate it with faith.

# Action Step:

Stop waiting for more signs.

Start acting on what God has already spoken.

- Submit the application.
- Make the call.
- Launch the vision.
- Take the meeting.
- Show up.

## VI. Evict Fear and Doubt—They Are Illegal Occupants (2 Timothy 1:7)

Fear and doubt are not just emotions.

They are spiritual barriers sent to block your progress.

But you have authority to evict them.

### 2 Timothy 1:7 (NIV):

"For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."

### Isaiah 41:10 (NIV):

"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

### Truth:

Fear and doubt have no legal right to dwell in you.

God gave you a spirit of power, love, and a sound mind.

You are not a hostage to your emotions.

You are a steward of your faith.

#### Action Step:

Speak faith over fear.

When fear says, "What if it doesn't work?" Faith says, "What if it does?"

When doubt says, "I'm not enough." Faith says, "God in me is more than enough."

# VII. You Are a Carrier of Divine Solutions (Matthew 5:14–16)

You are not just another person in the room.

You are a carrier of divine solutions.

Wherever you go, you bring answers.

#### Matthew 5:14–16 (NIV):

"You are the light of the world.

A town built on a hill cannot be hidden.

Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead, they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house.

In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."

## Truth:

People are waiting for what you carry.

Situations are waiting for your voice to speak breakthrough into them.

You are not empty-handed.

You are fully loaded with answers that heaven deposited inside you for such a time as this.

### Action Step:

Start releasing what's inside you.

- Bring clarity.
- Bring wisdom.
- Bring healing.
- Bring innovation.

# Conclusion: Align Your Mindset with Your Divine Assignment (Philippians 4:8)

You can't fulfill a divine assignment with a defeated mindset.

God didn't give you a calling just to have you second-guess it at every step.

## Philippians 4:8 (NIV):

"Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things."

# Truth:

Renew your mind daily with God's Word.

When your mindset aligns with your assignment, your decisions become bold, your actions become intentional, and your results begin to reflect kingdom authority and power.

### Final Call to Action:

From this day forward:

- Walk like it.
- Speak like it.
- Act like it.

And watch your life align with everything God has already ordained for you.

Your breakthrough is tied to your next act of faith.

Don't wait for confirmation—move in conviction.

Because when you move in faith, earth responds, and heaven releases.

Father, thank You for the power that lives inside of me.

I declare that I am full of Your strength, wisdom, and purpose.

- I reject fear and doubt.
- I embrace my kingdom identity.
- I speak life.
- I act in faith.
- I release what is inside me to bless the world.

I walk in boldness, knowing heaven backs every step I take.
